1928. The Ring was founded by Oswald Rae, who remained its President until 1947.
1929. The first British Ring Dinner held in London.
1930. Dleisfen appointed first Hon. Secretary.  
First typescript "Budget" published.
1931. First Annual Convention at Cheltenham, organized by Professor Bofeys.
1932. William G. Stickland appointed Hon. Secretary and Treasurer, the membership having increased to sixty-two.  
Second Annual Convention at Cheltenham.
1933. Convention at Northampton; local Organizers A. Valentine and A. Tear.

- 1935.) Conventions at Leamington Spa; local Organizer Milton Woodward.
1936. Convention at Northampton.
1937. Convention at Buxton.  
First monthly printed "Budget" issued under the Editorship of Levante. (Subsequent Editors Harry Kaye, Stanley Cable, Eric Wilson and (at present) Howard Denovan.
1938. Convention at Malvern.
1939. Convention at Southport.

- 1945 War years, during which no Conventions were held, but several functions were organized in London.  
The membership, numbering about 280, was closed, but on its re-opening in 1946 the Interrogation Officers System was introduced. Despite this, the increase in membership was rapid.
1946. The first post-war Convention at Hereford. Local Organizer W. Ollerhead.
1947. Convention at Buxton; Local Organizer G. Henriques.  
Herbert J. Collings elected President.
1948. Convention at Bournemouth; Local Organizers Wm. G. Stickland and Percy Bee.  
John Ramsay elected President.
1949. Present Membership about 800.
