RULES AND AWARDS

Rules relating to the Competition the awards of which are:

1. THE NEW SILVER BRITISH RING SHIELD and Cash Prize.

This will be awarded for the most entertaining magic act and is held for one year.

2. THE CONVENTIONEERS TROPHY

The greatest originality shown in effect, method or presentation and is held for one year

3. THE CRAIG TROPHY

For the performance by a lady magician who, in the opinion of the judges is worthy of this prize, and is held for one year.

THEO SPEAKER CUP and Cash Prize for runner-up

To be held for one year.

THIRD PRIZE - Cash Prize and Silver Wand presented by ALASTAIR

TOM HARRIS CUP (Comedy) (donated by Tom Harris) Together with Cash Prize

DITTIA SHIELD (Manipulation)

- These Competitions shall be open to all members of the British Ring providing (i) that they are fully paid up and accepted members or (ii) that application for membership shall have been received by the Secretary by the last day of May preceding the Competition.
- 2. The Management Committee of the Society shall appoint five magical Judges, including at the discretion of the Committee prominent visiting Magicians, together with a Chairman, who is also a member of the Society, and they will be responsible for the adjudication of the various awards. In the event of a tie the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- 3. If any member of the panel of Judges has been responsible for the production, tuition or guidance by way of advice to any competitor or feels that his personal relationship with any competitor may embarass him, he must inform the Hon. Secretary and stand down and allow for a replacement to be made.
- 4. There is no bar upon the number of awards that a competitor can win; It is possible for a male entrant to win the British Ring Shield, the Conventioneers Trophy, the Dittia Shield and Tom Harris Cup, whilst a lady entrant could win the British Ring Shield and the Tom Harris Cup, the Dittia Shield and the Craig Trophy.
- 5. The length of a competitor's act should not exceed ten minutes. A yellow warning light will indicate nine minutes and a red light and buzzer ten minutes. At ten and and a half minutes the competitor will automatically be disqualified and such disqualification will be announced from the stage before the appearance of the next act.
- Competitors who wish to be judged for manipulative skill, comedy or originality shall when completing the necessary entry form, give notice of such intention and they will be marked accordingly.
- The Judges shall have power to withhold any award if, in their opinion, the act or acts do not reach the required standard
- 8. A previous British Ring Shield winner shall not be allowed to enter and present the SAME ACT. There is, however, no bar to the presentation of a different act.
- Any Competitor who has taken part in the Competition for three successive years and failed to qualify for an award shall, unless the Committee of Management deem otherwise, have a waiting period of two years before entering again
- 10. Each Competitor will be allowed a maximum of two minutes to set his act.
- 11. The opening and closing acts will be decided by a draw and the names of the Competitors and running order shall be published in the Convention programme.
- 12. The presentation of every act should be considered as family entertainment and should be in good taste.
- 13. The closing date shall be one month before the date of the Convention.
- 14. Any matter not covered by the foregoing rules shall be decided by the Committee of Management whose decision shall be final.
- 15. Any trophy winners shall hold their award for a period of one year and such award must be returned to the Hon. Secretary in presentable condition at least two days prior to the day scheduled for the competition.





All items are first submitted for approval to the Honorary Secretary or before members of the General Committee before being listed.

New items will be added as possible and according to the needs of members.

A yearly balance sheet is submitted to the Honorary Treasurer.

In this way, A Sales Organisation was set-up which provided AN INVALUABLE SERVICE TO MEMBERS and at the same time without incurring the Society in any expense AND at the same time allowing the Society SOME ADDITIONAL REVENUE.

When you buy from British Ring Sales you are therefore purchasing something to promote the British Ring AND to help the British Ringfunds at the same time. Remember that 50% of the profits from all sales go to the Ring, (plus a good bit more).






