RULES AND AWARDS

Rules relating to the Competition the awards of which are:

1. THE NEW SILVER BRITISH RING SHIELD and Cash Prize.

This will be awarded for the most entertaining magic act and is held for one year.

2. THE CONVENTIONEERS TROPHY

The greatest originality shown in effect, method or presentation and is held for one year

3. THE CRAIG TROPHY

For the performance by a lady magician who, in the opinion of the judges is worthy of this prize, and is held for one year.

THEO SPEAKER CUP and Cash Prize for runner-up To be held for one year.

THIRD PRIZE - Cash Prize and Silver Wand presented by ALASTAIR

TOM HARRIS CUP (Comedy) (donated by Tom Harris)

DITTIA SHIELD (Manipulation)

THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF MAGICIANS BRITISH RING No.25.

Rules governing the British Ring Shield competition and other major awards to be competed at the annual convention.

- The competitions shall be open to all members of the British Ring providing:-(1) They are accepted and fully paid up members, or (2) application for membership has been received by the Hon. Secretary not later than the last day of June preceding the Competition.
- The Management Committee of the society shall appoint five Judges, comprising magical and lay. They shall also appoint a chairperson who shall be a member of the society. In the event of a tie the chairperson shall have the casting vote.
- If any member of the panel of judges has been responsible for the production, tuition or guidance by way of advice to any competitor or feels that any personal relationship would be an embarrassment, then the Hon Secretary must be informed, and the said Judge stand down, and a replacement shall be made.
- 4. There is no bar upon the number of awards that a competitor can win; it is possible for a male entrant to win the British Ring Shield, the Conventioneers Trophy, the Ditta Shield and the Tom Harris cup, whilst a lady entrant could win the British Ring Shield, the Tom Harris Cup, The Ditta Shield, Conventioneers Trophy, and the Craig Trophy.
- 5. The lengh of a competitor's act shall not exceed TEN minutes. At the end of NINE minutes a Yellow warning light will come on and a buzzer sound. At the end of TEN minutes a RED light will come on. If a Competitor continues beyond TEN and a HALF minutes then that will constitute automatic disqualification, and as such this will be announced prior to the next act competing.
- 6. All acts will be judged accordingly for all Awards.

prior to the day scheduled for the Competion.

- 7. The Judges shall have the power to withold any award if, in their opinion, the act or acts do not reach the required standard.
- 8. A previous British Ring Shield winner shall not be allowed to enter and present the SAME ACT. There is, however, no bar to the presentation of a different act.
- Any competitor who has taken part in the Competition for three succesive years and failed to qualify for an award shall, unless the Committee of Management deen otherwise, have a waiting period of two years before entering again.
- 10. Each Competitor will be allowed TWO minutes (MAXIMUM) to set the act. This will be timed by the Stage Manager.
- 11. The opening and closing acts will be decided by draw, the remaining acts drawn by style of act and the Competition running order put together to obtain the best balance of variety. It is THEREFORE ESSENTIAL that the Competition Questionnaire is filled in as fully as possible.
- 12. The Presentation of every act shall be considered as family entertainment and be in good taste.
- 13. The Closing date of the Competition entries shall be not less than SIX WEEKS prior to the Convention, and CONFIRMATION OF SUCH ENTRY WILL BE ON RECEIPT OF THE COMPETITION QUESTIONNAIRE, BY THE COMPETITION ORGANISER.
- Any matter not covered by the foregoing rules shall be decided by the Committee of Management whose decision shall be final.
 All trophy winners shall hold their award for a period of one year, or until the following Convention, which ever is the lesser, and such award must be returned to the Competition Organiser at the Convention Hotel in a presentable condition at least one day
- 16. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will the printed running order of the Competition be changed. Any artiste finding the order inconvenient due to professional or any other commitments will have to withdraw from the Competition.
