



It is our sincere wish that the members and guests of the British Ring enjoy another successful convention for which they have become so well known!



RULES AND AWARDS

Rules relating to the Competition the awards of which are:

1. THE NEW SILVER BRITISH RING SHIELD and Cash Prize.

This will be awarded for the most entertaining magic act and is held for one year.

2. THE CONVENTIONEERS TROPHY

The greatest originality shown in effect, method or presentation and is held for one year.

3. THE CRAIG TROPHY

For the performance by a lady magician who, in the opinion of the judges is worthy of this prize, and is held for one year.

THEO SPEAKER CUP and Cash Prize for runner-up To be held for one year.

THIRD PRIZE -Cash Prize and Silver Wand presented by ALASTAIR.

TOM HARRIS CUP (Comedy) (donated by Tom Harris).

DITTIA SHIELD (Manipulation).

THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF MAGICIANS BRITISH RING No. 25.

Rules governing the British Ring Shield competition and other major awards to be competed for at the annual convention. 01. The Competition shall be open to all members of the British Ring providing:- (1) They have REGISTERED FOR THE WHOLE CONVENTION, and (2) They are FULLY PAID UP MEMBERS, or their APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP has been received by the

Honorary Secretary NOT LATER THAN the LAST DAY OF JUNE Preceeding the Competition. O2. The Management Committee of the Society shall appoint six Judges comprising Magical and Lay. They shall appoint a Chairperson who shall be a Member of the Society. In the event of a tie the Chairperson shall have the casting vote.
 O3. If any member of the panel of Judges has been responsible for the production, tuition, or guidance by way of advice to any

Competitor or feels that any personal relationship would be an embarrasement, then the Honorary Secretary must be informed and the said Judge shall stand down, and a replacement shall be made

O4. There is no bar upon the number of awards that a Competitor can win; it is possible for a Male entrant to win the British Ring Shield, the Conventioneers Trophy, the Dittia Shield and the Tom Harris Cup, whilst a Lady Entrant could also win those awards mentioned above, together with the Craig Trophy.

O5 The length of a Competitor's act shall not exceed TEN minutes. At the end of NINE minutes a yellow warning light will come on and a Buzzer sound. At the end of TEN minutes a Red light will come on. If a Competitor continues beyond TEN and a HALF minutes the state will be appreciately the automatic disruptification and as such this will be appreciated by the bard temperature of the properties.

then that will constitute automatic disqualification, and as such this will be announced prior to the next act competing

06. All acts will be judged accordingly for all Awards.

70. The Judges shall have the power to withold any Award if, in their opinion, the act or acts do not reach the required standard.
 8. A Previous British Ring Shield winner shall not be allowed to enter and present the SAME ACT. There is, however, no bar to the presentation of a DIFFERENT ACT.
 9. Any Competitor who has taken part in the Competition for three successive years and failed to qualify for an Award shall, unless

the Committee of Management deem otherwise, have a waiting period of two years before entering again.

10. Each Competitor will be allowed TWO minutes (MAXIMUM) to set the act. This will be timed by the Stage Manager.

11. The opening and closing acts will be decided by draw, the remaining acts draw by style of act, and the Competition running order put together to obtain the best balance of variety. It is THEREFORE ESSENTIAL that the Competition Questionaire is filled in as fully as possible.

12. The presentation of every act shall be considered as family entertainment and be in good taste.

13. The CLOSING DATE of the Competition entries shall be NOT LESS THAN SIX WEEKS prior to the Convention, and CONFIRMATION OF SUCH ENTRY WILL ONLY BE ON RECEIPT OF THE COMPETITION QUESTIONAIRE, BY THE COMPETITION

14. Any matter not covered by the foregoing rules shall be decided by the Committee of Management whose decision shall be final.
15. All Trophy Winners shall hold their Award for a period of one year, or until the following Convention, which-ever is the lesser, and such award must be returned to the Competition Organiser at the Convention Hotel in a presentable condition at least one day prior to the day sceduled for the competition.

16. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will the printed running order of the Competition be changed. Any artist finding the order inconvenient due to professional or any other commitments will have to withdraw from the Competition

VIDEO CAMERAS
There will be no video taping of any performances (such as stage, lecture a close-up) in any of the official venues, lecture rooms or theatres, other than the above mentioned official video photographer. It is recommended the attendees leave their video cameras in their rooms as they will not be allow in the theatres.
Videotaping of interviews and impromptu performances or demonstration which take place in hotel or public places such as the banquet, receptions which are not disruptive to the convention programme is quite in order.

OTHER CAMERAS
No flash pictures of lectures, demonstrations or magical performances may taken at any time in any of the official venues, theatres or lecture rooms, out than by the above mentioned official photographer.

Still pictures may be taken using the existing light, provided that flash is a used and that such picture taking is not an annoyance to other spectators

AUDIO TAPE
Audio taping is allowed only with the permission of the performer.

NEWS MEDIA
News Media personnel must be authorised by the PRO and escorted by an officence of the performance o There will be no video taping of any performances (such as stage, lecture and close-up) in any of the official venues, lecture rooms or theatres, other than by the above mentioned official video photographer. It is recommended that attendees leave their video cameras in their rooms as they will not be allowed

Videotaping of interviews and impromptu performances or demonstrations which take place in hotel or public places such as the banquet, receptions etc

No flash pictures of lectures, demonstrations or magical performances may be taken at any time in any of the official venues, theatres or lecture rooms, other
