We all come together to honour our love for the art of magic, the family of magicians, and support of our organisations.


I hope to get a chance to meet you during the convention. Don't hesitate when you see me to stop and say hello.

THE HOPPING CHINESE COINS

The classic Hopping Halves effect, but with beautiful Chinese Coins! Two coins are shown, one red and one black. One coin is removed, but magically returns. This is repeated again and again and finally when you open your hand, it is empty! Very strong magic that is very easy to do. 


