STICKLAND STUDIO AND ATKINS CORNER

Bill Stickland and Jeffery Atkins are names that have a very strong affinity to the British Ring. Some of our newer members and delegates may not be aware of their background so we thought we would re-introduce these stalwarts once again. We want them to be remembered and during our convention we have the Jeffery Atkins Memorial Lecture, and the bronze bust of Bill Stickland which has adorned the stages of the venues over the years and is now part of our welcome at the Registration desk.

This year we thought we would bring their names to the fore once more and have named two of the areas for our events with them in mind, so when you want to know where to go, just look for the Stickland Studio and the Atkins Corner.

If you don't know who these remarkable men were, then read on and you will find out just what they did for the British Ring.

BILL STICKLAND

In 1932, William G Stickland (Bill) of Dorset then aged 32, went up to London to attend the annual dinner of the British Ring of the I.B.M. It was the last dinner to be organised by Dick Nesfield (Dleisfen), British Ring secretary since its formation in 1928, before his retirement from the post for personal and business reasons. What happened next can be summed up in Bill's own words.



'I did not anticipate when I left for dinner that I should return with the burden of the secretaryship on my shoulders'

He intended only being interim secretary until the end of the year, but in fact was still in post for the next 52 years until his death in 1984.

Bill, 'The Wessex Wizard' was a magician full of ingenious ideas and was one of the earliest contributors to both the Linking Ring and the Budget. He appeared regularly at the Ring events in London and also at the first convention in Cheltenham in 1931. His magic was unusual and would not work for everybody, but his themed presentations - his Tennis act, his Dice Man act and his remarkable 'Living Marionettes' were long remembered by all who saw them.

Although recognised as a singular magic entertainer, it is his outstanding work for the I.B.M. that is remembered with awe. He oversaw the growth of the British Ring from just under 100 members to over 1500 at the time of his death, he was President of the Ring twice and International President for 1971/72, the first non American to be so honoured. Later he

was awarded the I.B.M. Medal of Honour. In the UK he was appointed MBE, for 'services to magic', a rare honour for a magical entertainer.

JEFFERY ATKINS

In 1946 Bill was joined by Jeffery Atkins from the neighbouring county of Hampshire to be Assistant Secretary for the then growing society. Jeff got the magic bug early at school and was accepted as a member of the Associated Wizards of the South at the age of 14. He remained an enthusiastic member of that organisation for the rest of his life and was for a long period its President. He served in the navy during WW2 and on demobilisation began his long Ring involvement. He was then 27.



Descriptions of Jeff's early magic shows show him to be a performer with a broad range of general magic 'in the David Devant manner' as it was put at the time. Later British Ring convention audiences however, tend to remember him for his illusions. For 25 years until 1985 he presented 'Illusions of the Masters' on the convention Gala show. The illusions were either original from his own collection or reconstructions made especially for the shows. His act allowed modern audiences to see again famous illusions from the past.

In 1955 he added the role of Treasurer of the Ring to his responsibilities as well as assisting Bill especially during the years of Bill's declining health. After Bill's death in 1984 he became the Ring secretary, a role he performed with notable success until his own death in 2001. Like Bill before him, he was President of the Ring and International President of the I.B.M. in 1977, the second Briton to be so honoured. As he remarked in a speech 'The British Ring is my life, and as long as I have life, I will devote it to the Ring'.

Between them Bill and Jeffery served the British Ring for 63 years, a feat unlikely to be achieved again.

ARTISTS APPEARING

AARON CALVERT

Mind reader and hypnotist Aaron Calvert originally trained as a doctor before swapping his stethoscope for the stage. In the 3 years since graduating Aaron's career has rocketed. Two sell-out Edinburgh Fringe runs, 5 star reviews from national press and a recent Channel 4 hypnosis TV show. His natural charisma on stage and undeniable showmanship means Aaron has become highly sought after in the theatre and TV world. A master of hypnosis specialising in striking and thought provoking hypnotic feats Aaron will be sharing his techniques as taught on his refreshing approach course.

FIFTH DIMENSION

Fifth Dimension is Jeff Burns and Ivor Smith. Their work as magicians has taken them around the world - from Singapore to Hollywood's world famous Magic Castle and Las Vegas. Entertaining at corporate and private parties they captivate, amaze and inspire audiences with their magic. Combining humour, sleight of hand, mind reading, illusion and lots of audience participation they bring their unique form of madness to the stage with style, sophistication and the occasional hiccup. They are also world renowned presenters and TEDx speakers delivering keynote speeches at high profile business events and conferences where they use their magic to engage audiences with a range of topics including safety, leadership, creativity and working together.

DION

As a child growing up in Delft in the Netherlands, Dion van Rijt was fascinated by theatre, discovering magic as the perfect way to express himself and, finding that it fitted perfectly with ballet, he developed his first prize winning acts. Building on his success Dion became internationally known appearing on tv shows such as the Monte Carlo Magic Stars and in many famous venues including the Crazy Horse, Paris. His Magic Tango act won many international prizes and Dion became European Champion of Magic in 2011. His theatrical combination of surrealism, ballet, imagination and magic led to The Magic White Rabbit in 2013 and the dynamic fantasy character Mr Purpurs in 2016, both acts bringing more international recognition and success. Dion is currently working on two new acts, one of which will be seen for the first time in the UK here in Southport.

ROY FIELD

Roy has been involved in magic for nearly 60 years. When performing he specialised in cabaret and children's magic, but now concentrates mainly on researching magical history. He is the author of the official history of the British Ring, Linking Britain, published in 2011. At present, he is the lead columnist of the Gallery of Master Magicians in the Key Ring magazine. He was given the Award of Merit for 2017 by the IBM for articles in the Linking Ring.

WAYNE DOBSON

In 1977 Wayne Dobson jointly won the Zena Bennett trophy in the British Ring Close-up competition which led to his first TV appearance on Blue Peter; the rest is history ... his own TV series 'A Kind of Magic', theatre shows and tours, working Las Vegas and, of course, that appearance on the Royal Variety Show. A great star of British magic, winner of The Magic Circle's Maskelyne Award for his contribution to magic, Wayne continues to tour with his lecture and to write, invent and produce new magic; the British Ring is delighted to have him here at Southport!

MICHAEL FINNEY

Michael Finney is a stand up comedy magician. From his childhood years in school to this very day he has always wanted to make people laugh. As a professional bartender he found that with magic he could get paid while making drinks and still have fun making people laugh behind the bar. Soon the magic took over. He has received awards from Seigfried and Roy, the AMA Magic Castle in Hollywood and the World Magic Awards. He has been able to give back through magic by travelling to the Middle East and around the world numerous times entertaining troops from all over the world who value common freedoms. He started a foundation to help less fortunate in our world. Magic gave him every opportunity to become the person he is today.



SAM FITTON

Perhaps Andi Gladwin's greatest trick is how he divides his time between being a professional close-up magician, magic creator, author, co-founder of Vanishing Inc. Magic and lecturer. His Master Pushoff and Multiple Revelation Project DVDs were best sellers and received rave reviews in all major magic journals. His 'Magic Squared' effect is a true show stopper and his books 52 Memories and Blomberg Laboratories are both amongst the biggest selling magic books of the last decade. Andi has lectured at the biggest conventions in the world including The Session, Blackpool, FISM, Magi-Fest, MAGIC Live, The Genii Convention, and many more. He was recently featured on UK TV's 'Next Great Magician,' Penn & Teller: Fool Us and Masters of Illusion.

Marco Pusterla AIMC* is a well-known magic historian, publisher, author, lecturer and performer. He publishes the quarterly magazine Ye Olde Magic Mag and has organized the 2017 edition of the European Magic History Conference in Turin, Italy. In his own country, Vanni Pulé is a household name because of his hundreds of TV appearances over the years. He also performs close-up for conferences and corporate events. For magicians, he published various ideas on magic magazines on both sides of the Atlantic and he won the Howard Bamman Trophy twice. He also lectured to various societies. Between 2011 and 2012 he was International President of the International Brotherhood of Magicians.

QUENTIN REYNOLDS

Quentin has performed in almost all possible performing venues. From parties in private homes to the theatre stage. Some venues include performing outdoors in a field, in a GOAT BARN for the McDonell family (who make yoghurt up the Wicklow mountains), and the most memorable of all at the Charleville Cheese festival when a bus broke down in the middle of the audience.

SAFIRE ILLUSIONISTS

Safire have worked in theatres all over the world, including The Tropicana Hotel in Las Vegas. They have worked with many of the top names in show business including Joe Pasquale, Peter Kay, Ken Dodd, Richard Branson, Danny La Rue, Jimmy Tarbuck, Bradley Walsh and Joanna Lumley to name but a few. As well as performing, Stuart & Libby run a successful production company - 'Magic Light Productions', producing pantomimes every Christmas and touring children's shows across UK theatres. They also run 'Magic Light Puppets' and supply special effects and UV puppet sequences for production companies and events all over the UK and internationally.

A busy boy, Mike likes dynamic and to the point magic that will amaze and bemuse his audiences. So working with one of the most commercially prolific inventors of magic, it's not hard to assume his magic is exactly what it says on the tin.

ALEXANDER WELLS

Alexander has spent the last ten years creating and performing original and imaginative magic on stages around the U.K. and Europe. After beginning as a street performer, Alexander moved on to work in cabaret and variety in theatres and clubs around the country. In 2015 he joined the cast of the House of Illusion magic theatre in Spain as compere. Alexander quickly became a principal stage performer before taking on the role of Head Magician, leading the show, working with other magicians on their acts and assisting with writing, magic consulting and directing. He now works for private clients around the U.K. and performs on cruise ships.

Alexander's Multiplying Bottles routine has become his signature piece attracting plaudits and acclaim from respected peers in magic. His show encompasses humorous, post-modern re-imaginings of classical themes in magic and performance.
